Abortion is the termination of a pregnancy before the fetus is able to live outside the womb, usually prior to 20 - 24 weeks. Abortion has many classifications. They may be spontaneous (miscarriage), in which there is no outside intervention that results in the loss of pregnancy, or induced, either electively or for therapeutic reasons.

Preconceptual and prenatal counseling and care are the most important interventions for prevention of spontaneous abortion in women with no prior history of miscarriage. Use of pharmacologic therapy (eg, estrogen, vitamins, aspirin) has not been found to be effective.

Treatment of septic abortion is intensive antibiotic therapy plus uterine evacuation as soon as possible. A typical antibiotic regimen includes clindamycin 900 mg IV every 8 hours plus gentamicin 5 mg/kg IV once a day, with or without ampicillin 2 g IV every 4 hours.
